When the cumulus cloud becomes very large, the water in it become large and heavy. Raindrops start to fall through the cloud, cool dry air starts to enter the cloud. Because cool air is heavier than warm air, it starts to descend in the cloud (known as a downdraft). The downdraft pulls the heavy water downward, making rain.
